From the Desk of Nurse Iris

With the cold and flu season in full swing, sometimes it's hard to know if we should send our children to school or not. Here are some guidelines to help.



When should a child be kept home from school?

- If they have been vomiting within the last 24 hours
- If they have diarrhea
- If they have a fever of 100 or higher
- If they have a frequent, persistent cough

-If they require an over-the-counter cold or flu medicine or pain reliever in the morning in order to attend school.

Remember - Students may return to school 24 hours AFTER the symptoms are ALL GONE.
