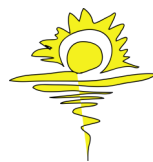

From the Desk of Nurse Iris

Sometimes it's hard to know if we should send our children to school or not. Here are some guidelines to help.

When should a child be kept home from school?

- If they have been vomiting within the last 24 hours
- If they have diarrhea
- If they have a fever of 100 or higher
- If they have a frequent, persistent cough
- If they require an over-the-counter cold or flu medicine or pain reliever in the morning in order to attend school.



Remember - Students may return to school 24 hours
AFTER the symptoms are gone!
