EARLY RELEASE

FOR STUDENTS

1:45 p.m.

School buses will be at school to transport students at 1:45 p.m.

Boys and Girls Club will open at 1:45pm.



When should a child be kept home from school?

-If they have been vomiting within the last 24 hours

-If they have diarrhea

-If they have a fever of 100 or higher

-If they have a frequent, persistent cough

-If they require an over-the-counter cold or flu medicine or pain reliever in the morning in order to attend school.

Remember - Students may return to school 24 hours AFTER the symptoms are ALL GONE.

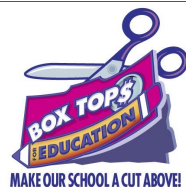
